This tour packs in five days of epic riding, starting and finishing in Christchurch - taking in some of the best of Canterbury, West Coast, Central Otago and Mackenzie country regions in the South Island.

Experience a large range of riding experiences from breath-taking winding highways, epic lake vistas, climbing over some of the most famous high country stations, historic gold mining trails and alpine passes such as Arthurs Pass, Danseys Pass, Nevis Valley, Lake Onslow and Old Dunstan Road, you will definitely not be disappointed!

Four nights accommodation is included in the tour including overnights in Franz Josef, Queenstown, Alexandra and Omarama, providing a great look around some amazing NZ towns and local experiences.

The tour has an "off-the-beaten-track" focus with some highway riding to begin with, then into a lot of gravel roads, 4WD tracks and some stream crossings to keep the adrenaline pumping. The tour is therefore only suited to riders with gravel and off-road riding experience, and able to handle a large adventure motorcycle off the blacktop tar-sealed highway environment. Our expert guides will be there to assist, or offer advice and riding tips if required.

WHAT DOES THE TOUR INCLUDE?

Our team have planned and designed this tour based on years of adventure riding, travel experience and contacts throughout New Zealand. The routes, sights, and experiences on this tour have been selected to showcase a broad selection of what the South Island has to offer. We have taken all the hard work out of organising such an epic tour, so you can truly sit back in the saddle and enjoy the Adventure!

- **Motorcycle** Your choice of KTM adventure motorcycle from our fleet (subject to availability). We operate KTM 890, 790, 690 and 390 models to suit different rider abilities and preferences. See the bike models and pricing pages.
- **Motorcycle fuel** All the fuel (petrol) for your bike is covered in the tour package cost. The tour will stop for fuel frequently with no chance of you running out.
- Planned Routes Pre-ridden routes, selecting some of the best adventure riding routes the South has to offer.
- **Tour Guides** Experienced adventure motorcycle tour guides who have been there and done it before. A riding guide will lead the tour so there is no chance of getting lost. For groups of 6 or more there will also be a second riding guide running at the rear in support to ensure everyone is on track and no one gets left behind. Tap into their local knowledge and maybe even pick up some adventure riding tips along the way.
- **Pre-Ride Briefings** We provide a full ride and safety briefing prior to our tour departure, and before each days riding. Briefings detail the route, break locations, any hazards or harder sections, sight-seeing opportunities, tourist and photo opportunities, and any optional extra riding sections available for when time allows.
- **Breakfast** Breakfast is provided daily during the tour. Other meals including lunches and dinners are at the individuals own expense. We stop frequently for refreshment and lunch breaks during each day.
- **GPS Routes** Garmin Zumo XT GPS units are supplied on all bikes with daily routes preloaded.
- Accommodation At the end of each day during the tour, rest easy in the knowledge that your accommodation is
 taken care of. With a range of different accommodation including Hotels and Motels depending on our location for
 the night. Standard accommodation is twin share. If you are a single rider you will be allocated a ½ twin share
 room, the room will be shared with another tour participant of the same sex. A single room option is available at
 additional cost. Please advise after booking if you require the single room option.
- Mechanical Assistance In the rare event that you have a mechanical issue with the bike e.g. flat tyre, our guides
 will be on hand to fix the problem, or arrange assistance for any major mechanical failures.
- Medical Assistance All our tour guides and support staff hold formal First Aid training qualifications and are
 there to assist with any medical issues or accidents. For more serious medical events our guides also carry
 emergency locator and communication devices for fast response from New Zealand Emergency Services.
- T-Shirt Been there, done that and got the T-Shirt! An Ultimate Adventure Moto NZ Tour T-Shirt is included.

ITINERARY

Pre Tour Arrival – It is recommended that participants arrange to be in Christchurch on the day before the tour, as Day 1 has an early 8:00am start at the Ultimate Adventure Moto depot. Unfortunately we are unable to provide airport transfers or pickups on the morning of Day 1 due to a busy morning greeting guests, conducting briefings and getting organised for the tour departure. Therefore participants need to make their own way to Ultimate Adventure Moto depot by 8:00am on Day 1.

Our Day 1 pre-tour briefing includes;

- Welcome & Introduction staff introduction & participants meet and greet, complimentary tea/coffee
- **Tour check-in** final paperwork and security deposit processing
- Tour Description outlining the route and some of the sights and activities
- Riding in New Zealand brief road rules, conditions, hazards and what to expect
- **Health & safety briefing** what to do in case of any emergencies.
- Gear Check we will check all riders to ensure suitable safe riding gear is being worn
- **Bike handover** run over bike and GPS setup and functions

After the pre-tour briefing we will pack our paniers and bags, gear up and get ready for the first days ride to Franz Josef on the fabulous West Coast!

ROUTE IN DETAIL

Day 1 - Christchurch to Franz Josef - 410km+

Leaving Christchurch and heading west via some gravel roads and Lake Coleridge to the majestic Arthurs Pass. Experience jaw dropping scenery on this alpine highway through native forests and mountain valleys - you may even see a naughty Kea at the Otira viaduct. Then onto the rugged West Coast which doesn't disappoint with deserted coastal highways and great mountain scenery. Finishing Day 1 at Franz Josef township where you can get a look at the glaciers and unique coastal environment.

Day 2 - Franz Josef to Queenstown - 340km+

A highway transition day departing Franz and heading south via the West Coast and dense native bush into the Haast Pass before arriving at the first of the stunning southern lakes and the beautiful lakeside town of Wanaka where we stop for lunch. From here is through the Cardrona Valley with its famous historic pub, then over the stunning Crown Range and zig zag road down to Arrowtown before arriving in the tourist mecca of Queenstown. For the adventurous and if time allows head into the historic skippers canyon for an amazing backcountry gravel excursion.

Day 3 - Queenstown to Alexandra - 280km+

Todays route winds down the side of Lake Wakatipu via the Devils Staircase to Garston where we meet our first real taste of back-country gravel. Climbing steeply up the base of the Hector Mountains to 1100m then traversing the famous Nevis Valley, with a good section of 4WD tracks and some creek and river crossings to keep the adrenaline pumping. Hawksburn Road power pylon track is up next before dropping into Clyde and past the hydro dam. If time is going well it is onwards to Cromwell for lunch then over some high country farm land and plenty of farm gates through Thompsons Gorge before dropping into the Manuherikia Valley and back to Alexandra to reminisce on a good days back-country riding over a well earned refreshment or two.

Day 4 - Alexandra to Otematata - 330km+

Shortly after Alexandra a steep climb to over 1600m on a 4WD track onto the Old Man Range where the unique Obelix monolith stares out over the valley below, before descending back down and driving over the Roxburgh hydro dam. A short fuel and pie stop in Roxburgh before heading back country past Lake Onslow then back to civilisation at Ranfurly and Naseby. From there it's into the gravel action again thru rolling farmland before arriving at Kyeburn Diggings and the historic Danseys Pass Hotel where it's worth the stop for a coffee or refreshment. Danseys Pass is next with plenty of awesome sweeping gravel corners. Out onto the highway again takes us to Otematata for the night where we will chill out, tell some tales over a meal and a drink at the local pub.







Day 5 - Otematata-Christchurch - 390km

Two options for the trip back to Christchurch which will be decided on the day depending on weather conditions and river levels. Either a gravel blast up Hakataramea Pass, Mackenzie Pass and Burkes Pass to Fairlie, or over Lake Benmore dam then through Black Forest Station high country farm and onto the glacial lakes of Pukaki and Tekapo, where if the weather is fine will give majestic views of Aoraki Mount Cook. At Fairlie is a near compulsory stop at the famous bakery for lunch or at any of the other local cafes to refuel the body. After Fairlie is on the highway to Geraldine and the inland scenic route back to Christchurch via the Rakia Gorge and Darfield. Arriving back








at the depot late in the afternoon where the official part of the tour comes to an end.

(Please Note: The tour route may be subject to change slightly due to weather conditions, private farm operations, road closures, delays or any other unforeseen circumstances.)

MOTORCYCLE MODELS

We exclusively use KTM motorcycles, the proven weapon of choice for the terrain encountered on our tours.

We have used numerous other makes and models of bikes in the past and while others are capable, the KTM's consistently outshine other bikes due to their all-round exceptional capability for this type of riding. The KTM models we use are simply the best bikes available, so why would we (or you) accept anything less?!



KTM 890 Adventure R

The most formidable off-road weapon in the KTM lineup and proves that the destination really does come second. With its unmatched ability to dispatch everything from highways to rocky gravel switchbacks and single goat tracks, this bike never disappoints! (For experienced riders only.)

Suited to: Intermediate and advanced riders only, with large bike offroad experience.



KTM 790 Adventure R

With its true adventure bike stature along with its lightweight, the KTM 790 Adventure R is a breath of fresh air in the medium adventure bike class. With its top-spec suspension, it has a go-anywhere feel whether that's on-road or off. Well equipped as standard it is perfectly suited for a rider with off-road experience or someone who wants to undertake their first true adventure ride.

Suited to: Intermediate or better riders wanting a forgiving mid-weight bike with great performance.



KTM 690 Enduro R

Master challenging terrain on this lightweight, high-performance king of versatility. Feel the adrenaline build while chasing tarmac curves towards the offroad destination. Just twist the throttle of the KTM 690 ENDURO R, which really comes into its own when the dirt begins and the trail gets more extreme. The perfect all round adventure machine!

All our bikes are meticulously maintained, checked and serviced before every tour. We use Motoz full knobbly tyres, which are either brand new or near new at the start of every ride.

TOUR NAVIGATION INFORMATION

A daily route briefing will be conducted each morning to explain what to expect for the days' ride ahead, however, the main source of navigation comes in the form of GPS track files. A Garmin Zumo XT GPS device is installed on each motorcycle with the daily routes preloaded. Riders will depart in a group together between 8.00-9.00am each morning and are required to follow the planned GPS route. You will be briefed on the operation of the GPS unit before departing on the tour.



BIKE LUGGAGE PROVIDED

Tour participants are required to carry all their own personal gear required for the tour on their supplied motorcycle. Because the tour utilises good Hotel/Motel accommodation, participants will not need to carry excessive amounts of additional gear other than what they would like to wear in the evenings after changing out of riding gear (Please see the following gear section for recommended gear to bring).

*Note Participants are not required to carry any tools, tubes or spare parts, first aid, or emergency equipment. This is the tour leader and guides responsibility.

All bikes come with the Kriega OS Pannier System installed on the bike to carry your gear.



Kriega OS Panier System

Soft Side Paniers mounted on a saddle base attached to the rear of the bike.

Remove your contents from the side bags each night, or the whole system can be removed from the bike.

Large 18L bags on each side. (Total 36L)

If you need additional luggage space we can provide a rear mounted drybag to carry additional items.



SW Motech Drybag

This roll-top waterproof dry bag is a good simple system that is easily attached and removed from the rear of the bike to take into your hotel room each night.

Samll (18L), Medium (26L) or Large (35L) available

Prior to departure on day one, you will pack all the personal gear you will be taking on tour for 5 days into the motorcycle luggage on the bike.

*Note You can leave your travel suitcases/bags and any excess items not required for the tour at the Ultimate Adventure Moto NZ secure storage area at our depot. This will be ready for you to pick up when we return at the end of the tour.

PREREQUISITES

The Southern Passes tour is a backcountry adventure motorcycle ride focussing on gravel roads and 4WD tracks with some technical sections including rough terrain, steep climbs and descents, steep drop-offs, and multiple water crossings. The tour is therefore designed for intermediate ability riders and above with gravel road riding experience.

THE SOUTHERN PASSES TOUR IS NOT SUITABLE FOR BEGINNER RIDERS.

Tour participants must:

- Have a motorcycle licence valid for riding in New Zealand, and
- Be a minimum of 25 years old, and
- Have some off-road or gravel riding experience, and
- Be comfortable riding in rough, bumpy, narrow, and steep terrain, and
- Be able to ride standing up on motorcycle footpegs including over small obstacles

While our experienced guides can assist riders through more difficult sections if required, the guides are not there to instruct or help inexperienced riders to complete the tour. Beginner and inexperienced riders may slow the group progress during the tour and cause delays and frustration for other participants. If you have any doubt about the rider skill level required please contact us to discuss <u>before</u> booking.

BOOKING PROCESS

Booking is via our online website tour booking page <u>www.ultimateadventuremoto.co.nz/southern-passes-adventure-tour</u> (If you prefer we can do this for you, please contact us to arrange.)

- 1. Goto <u>www.ultimateadventuremoto.co.nz/southern-passes-adventure-tour</u> select the tour date required, and click on "Book Now"
- 2. Select your choice of motorcycle from available models (subject to availability).
- 3. Add to Cart and complete the checkout process by entering your personal details.

- 5. After booking an invoice will be sent for balance of booking which must be paid 60 days prior to tour start date.

WHAT DO I NEED TO BRING?

While we provide most things you need for the 5-day tour we can't supply absolutely everything, particularly personal items. You will need to bring with you the following items:

- **Personal Clothing** At the end of each days riding you will want to change out of your riding gear into something a little more comfortable. Please bring with you changes of clothes for 5 days of travel. New Zealand has very changeable weather so make sure you have packed some warmer clothing if it gets cool. Some destinations will have a laundry service or laundry available for you to do your own clothes washing if required.
- Motorcycle Riding Gear It is best if you bring your own riding gear to ensure accurate fit and comfort. We do
 have a selection of riding gear for hire at additional cost however for your own comfort we suggest you bring your
 own gear. We do not hire boots. We suggest bringing the following as a minimum:

- Armoured Jacket
- Armoured Pants
- Warm Touring Gloves
- Lightweight Enduro style Gloves
- Boots Enduro or Adventure style
- Base layers, thermal pants & top
- Warm removable mid layers
- Waterproof outer shell

- Neck warmer/Buff
- Hydration backpack
- Goggles
- Sunglasses
- Sunscreen

Optional

- GPS/Smartphone Navigation
- Helmet comms

We have a selection of new riding gear and accessories available at our online store, and in our depot in Christchurch. If you would like to order any items we can have them ready for you at the start of your tour. Please contact us for more information.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

PAYMENT POLICY

Ultimate Adventure Moto NZ Ltd Payment Policy

- A non-refundable deposit of NZD\$1,500 is required to secure your place on the tour and confirm your motorcycle selection from available models.
- Deposit payments are to be made by Credit Card via the online booking system on our website www.ultimateadventuremoto.co.nz/adv-tours. All deposits are non-refundable.
- An invoice will be emailed to you for the outstanding balance with full payment due 60 days before the tour departure. Payment can be made via bank transfer Direct Credit or Credit Card. Invoice payments via credit card will incur a 2.9% surcharge.
- If Ultimate Adventure Moto NZ Ltd has not received the final balance payment within 60 days before the start of the tour, the deposit will be forfeited and the booking cancelled.
- A Bond of NZD\$2,500 is required per motorcycle hire at the commencement of the tour. (See Insurance terms and conditions below.)
- All prices shown are in New Zealand Dollars (\$NZD)
- All prices include New Zealand Government Goods and Services Tax (GST) of 15%

CANCELLATION POLICY

PARTICIPANT CANCELLATION

A participant may withdraw from the tour at any time by notifying Ultimate Adventure Moto NZ Ltd in writing via email or dated letter. In case of withdrawal, a cancellation fee calculated by reference to the total tour fee is payable as follows:

- More than 60 days before the tour start date: Loss of the non-refundable deposit.
- 60-30 days before the tour start date: 50% of the total tour cost.
- 0-29 days before the tour start date: 100% of the total tour cost.
- If you do not show up at the scheduled start time of the tour for any reason, 100% of the tour cost will be forfeited.
- We strongly advise taking out your own personal travel insurance for any unforeseen circumstances that would prevent you from attending the tour.

TOUR CANCELLATIONS

Ultimate Adventure Moto NZ Ltd reserves the right to cancel any scheduled tour at any time due to lack of participation, severe weather, natural disaster, world unrest, pandemic or any other given reason whatsoever.

If any tour is cancelled, Ultimate Adventure Moto NZ Ltd will;

- Immediately notify tour participants of any such occurrence, and
- Offer the possibility of rescheduling another tour on another date, or will refund the tour deposit and tour balance less any deposits paid to cover pre-booked accommodation, activities and admin fees etc. which will constitute a full settlement.
- Not be liable for any additional cost or losses incurred by the participant due to a cancellation of any tour. This may include, but not be limited to;
 - personal airline tickets,
 - o other accommodation reservations,
 - o any other pre-planned trips/travel and/or associated expenses.

INSURANCE TERMS & CONDITIONS

Motorcycle Insurance

• Full comprehensive motorcycle insurance is included in the tour fee for all motorcycle hires.

Security Deposit (BOND)

- At the commencement of the tour a bond of NZD\$2,500.00 is required to be held for each motorcycle rental in the event of any
 damage or loss to either the motorcycle, any accessories or third party property. This sum is fully refundable if the motorcycle
 and any accessories are returned at the conclusion of the tour without any damage, loss or expense. Any damage will be
 deducted from the insurance bond with the balance being refunded. The hirers maximum liability is limited to the full insurance
 bond plus any cost of recovery of the motorcycle. (All damages paid by credit card will incur a 2.9% credit card surcharge.)
- The bond must be taken in the form of a pre-authorisation on your Credit Card at the commencement of the tour and is held for the duration of your hire. Please ensure sufficient funds are available on your Credit Card for the bond pre-authorisation hold at the commencement of your tour. Note: Pre-Authorisation holds can only be charged to a Credit Card. Debit Cards are not valid.
- After the bond hold pre-authorisation is cancelled it may take up to 3-5 working days for the funds to be available again on your Credit Card depending on your bank.
